Shelving With Boxes – Spacing Guide



When building a bay of shelving that requires a certain shelf height to fit boxes, please use the following steps as a guide

1 When adding side beams to the uprights, start from the top and work down

Note: If bay has split uprights, connect uprights together prior to adding side beams

2 Use box as a spacing guide to know which holes to put the next side beam into

Note: Space may also be required for chipboard shelf

3 Continue to evenly space out the side beams onto the uprights for the number of shelves required

4 When building each shelf level using the front & back beams, start at the bottom, adding the chipboard each time before moving onto the next level

5 Continue this process when adding remaining shelf levels
