Frequently Asked Questions FAQ's

What environments do we recommend the PVC floor tiles be used for?

- ◆ Garage and workshop
- ◆ Commercial and industrial
- ◆ Gym and utility

Do I require any tools for installation?

- ◆ A non-marking rubber mallet or hammer
- ◆ For smaller installations, a Stanley knife will be satisfactory for cutting tiles to fit the space
- ◆ For larger installations, a jigsaw or guillotine may be required for cutting tiles

What type of edging do I need?

- ◆ For one side – You can choose either male or female edging to fit
- ◆ For two adjacent sides – Half male and half female edging
- ◆ For two opposing sides – Half male and half female edging

How much edging do I need?

- ◆ General rule – one edge per tile
- ◆ However, if you want to create a corner with the edging; allow one extra edge per side, per corner

Where to start the installation?

- ◆ Use a chalk line to mark out the centre of the room

How can I protect my flooring from physical damage?

- ◆ For example: Highlighting possible indentation from pressure points
What to avoid - moving appliances on the tiles, if damages occur can simply remove and replace single tiles etc

What if I order the wrong amount?

- ◆ Under-ordered? You can place a small quantity order for any additional tiles or edges to complete your flooring
- ◆ Over-ordered? Our interlocking tiles are brilliant for most environments, if you cannot make use of these tiles, please see our returns policy
